Dash Arts and Co-Artistic Directors Josephine Burton and Tim Supple announce the launch of an International Performance Lab.

In late November, Dash Arts will offer an unmissable artistic and professional development opportunity exploring performance in the unique Dash Arts style -- across art-forms, languages and cultural background. This **International Performance Lab** is targeted to UK-based performers (actors, musicians, actor-musicians) originally from another country.

Over two weeks (w/c 20 November and w/c 27 November), participants will work with Dash Arts' Artistic Directors, Tim Supple and Josephine Burton exploring the novella **SOUL** by the great Russian writer Andrei Platonov, an extraordinary tale of a nomadic community of different races and ethnicities in Central Asia in the 1930s.

The two weeks (generally 10-6) will be a collective, physical, playful and instructive sharing, of skills and experience. We will end the sessions with a public sharing work-in-progress. There will also be opportunity for practical advisory, development and mentoring sessions targeted to the needs and wishes of our Performance Lab participants.

We are looking for performers - primarily actors, musicians, or actor-musicians - who have had some professional training (although not necessarily in the UK or in English).

The Performance Lab will generally run Monday-Saturday from 10am-6pm (there are a couple of exceptions) at Rich Mix in Bethnal Green. We prefer that participants are available for all sessions (especially the sharing date on Saturday evening, 2 December) but can work around some unavailability.
